

# Competition Terms & Conditions



## Community Cricket Volunteer

### PARTICIPATION

1. This competition ("Competition") is conducted by Suncorp-Metway Limited ABN 66 010 831 722 trading as Suncorp Bank ("the Promoter") of Level 28, Brisbane Square, 266 George Street, Brisbane, Queensland.
2. All entry instructions and prize information published by the Promoter form part of these conditions. By entering, entrants accept these conditions.
3. The Competition is only open to individuals who: (i) are Queensland residents aged 18 years or older at time of entry; and (ii) are not directors, management or employees, or their immediate family members, of the Promoter, Bull Masters Limited ("**Bulls Masters**") or their related companies or agencies associated with the Competition ("Eligible Entrant").
4. The Eligible Entrant must obtain consent of the nominated community cricket club member ("**Nominated Entrant**") prior to entry into the Competition. Entry by the Eligible Entrant into the Competition is deemed agreement by the Nominated Entrant to these Competition Conditions. The Nominated Entrant must be a Queensland resident.
5. Competition entry commences at 9.00am on Monday 19 October, 2015 and closes at 5.00pm on Monday 30 November, 2015 ("Entry Period"). Except as otherwise stated, all times are Queensland time.

### ENTRY

6. To enter the Competition, an Eligible Entrant must, during the Entry Period:
  - i. log onto [www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters](http://www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters); and
  - ii. Nominate their Community Cricket Champion (Nominated Entrant) by:
    - i. Registering at [www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters](http://www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters);
      - a. Completing and submitting an application; and
      - b. Confirming that the Nominated Entrant is a Queensland resident and has provided his or her consent to be nominated as part of this competition.
7. Individual nominations only will be accepted – Groups of people are not eligible for nomination.
8. Persons who are paid for their volunteering role within a Community Cricket Club (other than reimbursement for expenses) are ineligible for nomination.
9. The Promoter reserves the right to display or publicise all nominations and Nominated Entrants may be required for media interviews and publicity.
10. Nominated Entrants and Eligible Entrants must not be the same person.
11. Nominations must be received by the Promoter via the online portal – [www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters](http://www.suncorpbank.com.au/bullsmasters) by close of business (AEST) on the final day of the Entry Period. Nominations received after this time will not be eligible and therefore not considered for the 2016 Competition.
12. Entries will be deemed received at the time that the Promoter is satisfied that all necessary requirements under condition 6 have been met and not at the time of submission by the Eligible Entrant. The Promoter takes no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, illegible or misdirected entries or delays or failures in any equipment or telecommunications service used to administer this Competition.
13. Cost of entry via the internet is free, but internet connection and usage rates may apply. Eligible Entrants should obtain details of such costs from their service providers.
14. Eligible Entrants must submit their internet entry manually. The Promoter may reject internet entries if it reasonably forms the opinion that they have been entered using automated entry means or by use of a competition entry service.
15. Eligible Entrants must create their own entry and only submit an entry in their own name. Entries that are found to have been derived from third party work will be considered invalid and, if awarded a prize, the prize must be returned to the Promoter. Each Eligible Entrant indemnifies the Promoter and its associated companies and agents for any claims, costs, expenses, penalties or damages they incur from reproducing, publishing or otherwise using any works subsequently found to have been derived in any way from any third party works.
16. Each Eligible Entrant warrants and agrees that:
  - a. they have created the entry themselves;
  - b. they are entitled to reproduce and exploit all underlying works in the entry;
  - c. the entry does not, and use or exploitation of the entry by the Promoter (and each of its assignees and licensees) as contemplated by these conditions will not, violate the rights (including copyright and privacy) of any third person;
  - d. the entry has not been previously published in any other medium or forum worldwide;
  - e. they will not submit material that is unlawful, obscene, defamatory, derogatory, abusive, harmful to any person or entity, or otherwise inappropriate or offensive; and
  - f. they have not granted rights to their entry to any other person which is inconsistent with the rights granted to the Promoter under these conditions.
17. Each Eligible Entrant acknowledges and agrees that the Promoter (and each of its assignees and licensees) has the right, in its absolute discretion, to edit, amend, copy, reproduce, use, publish, broadcast and communicate to the public, the entry in any media including television and the internet, without any further consultation, reference, payment or other compensation. Each Eligible Entrant also agrees that they will not make any claim against the Promoter (or its assignees and licensees) arising from the exercise of these rights, including claims in relation to any moral rights that they may otherwise have.
18. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, declare an entry invalid or disqualify any entrant that tampers with the entry process or benefits from such tampering, submits an entry that is incomplete or not in accordance with these conditions, or otherwise acts in a manner that is disruptive, dishonest or calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of this Competition.
19. The Promoter reserves the right to require an entrant to verify the validity of their entry within the requested time, including but not limited to an entrant's identity, eligibility, age and address and to disqualify any entrant who does not satisfy any entry criteria in these conditions. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Proof considered suitable for verification is at the Promoter's discretion.

### JUDGING AND PRIZES

20. This Competition is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner(s).
21. Competition judging will take place on Friday 11 December 2015 at [Suncorp Offices, 266 George Street, Brisbane Square, Brisbane ]. All valid entries received during the Entry Period will be judged by the Promoter's judging panel consisting of representatives of the Promoter, Bulls Masters and a non-Suncorp Bank/non-Bulls Masters representative. Judging will be based on the demonstration of core values as follows:

- A long term commitment by the Nominated Entrant to the cricket club / club tenure
  - A compelling reason or need to support the Nominated Entrant and the cricket club
  - Display of integrity and respect for members of the cricket club by the Nominated Entrant
  - Nominated Entrant's contribution to the cricket club
  - Nominated Entrant's involvement and support in the day-to-day running of the cricket club.
  - Consideration will also be given as to how the Eligible Entrant can articulate how the winning grant will be used to improve the services of the cricket club.
22. The total prize pool is valued at approximately \$13,000 as at the date of commencement of the Competition. A prize value is the recommended retail value as provided by the relevant supplier(s). The Promoter takes no responsibility for any variation in a prize's value due to exchange rate changes or otherwise.
23. The prize pool includes:
- a. \$2,000 deposited into a Suncorp Bank Account of the Winner
  - b. \$5,000 Grant for the Winner's community cricket club (to be spent on equipment, program, goods or services for the cricket club).
  - c. BBQ celebration and coaching session at the Winners' community cricket club to be held at a mutually agreeable date before 31 March 2016 and will be determined between the Promoter and the community cricket club.
  - d. \$500 deposited into each of the four regional finalists individual bank accounts
  - e. \$1,000 Grant for each of the regional finalists community cricket club (to be spent on equipment, program, goods or services for the cricket club)

## PRIZE WINNERS

24. The Winner (Community Cricket Champion) will be notified by a phone call on Tuesday 19 January 2016 using the details provided in the entry submitted by the Eligible Entrant.
25. The Winner will receive their Award at a community BBQ to be held at an agreed date before 31st March 2016 at the Winner's community cricket club. The date and time will be decided between the club, the Promoter and the Bulls Masters. Bulls Masters players will present the Winner with their prize.
26. The prize(s) will only be awarded following any winner validation and verification that the Promoter requires in its sole discretion.
27. The Winner's prize individual prize will be deposited into a Suncorp Bank transaction account. The Winner will be required to open a Suncorp Bank transaction account if they do not hold such an account, within 30 days from notification of winning the prize.
28. Where the Winner needs to open a Suncorp Bank transaction account they will need to comply with Suncorp Bank's usual account opening procedures including:
- a. completing and signing an account opening form;
  - b. receiving a Product Information Document for the relevant account; and
  - c. being identified as required by Suncorp Bank.
29. The \$5,000 grant to the Winner's cricket club will be deposited into the club's nominated account.
30. Each of the regional finalists cash prizes will be deposited into the individual's bank account (the four finalists will not be required to open a Suncorp Bank account).
31. The \$1,000 grant to each of the regional finalists cricket clubs will be deposited into each club's nominated account.

32. The grant contributions to the Winner and regional finalists' community cricket clubs must be spent on providing goods, services, programs, equipment or general improvements to the club. Each community cricket club which receives a grant may be asked to provide evidence of how funds were allocated.

## GENERAL

33. If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned, or is interfered with or disrupted in any way (including by vandalism, power failures, natural disasters, acts of God, weather event, civil unrest, strikes, computer bugs or viruses, tampering or technical failures), the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition, or invalidate any affected entries.
34. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for: (i) any error, omission, interruption, or delay in the operation or transmission of any communication sent to (or by) the Promoter or any entrant whether caused by problems with communication networks or lines, computer systems, software or internet service providers, congestion on any carrier network or otherwise; (ii) any theft, destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of such communications; (iii) any problem with, or technical malfunction of, any computer system or other equipment used for the conduct of the Competition; (iv) any incorrect or incomplete information which may be communicated in the course of the administering this Competition (whether as a result of one of the foregoing causes or otherwise); or (v) any delay in delivery (when not directly caused by the Promoter or its supplier), or failure of safe delivery of a prize.
35. All of the Promoter's decisions in relation to all aspects of this Competition are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
36. A winner accepts a prize at their own risk. Any tax liability arising as a result of accepting a prize is the responsibility of the winner. Independent financial advice should be sought.
37. The Winner and winning community cricket club must, at the Promoter's request, participate in all promotional activity (such as publicity and photography) surrounding winning a prize, free of charge, and consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice (including any photograph, film and/or recording of them) in promotional material in any media at any time without notification or compensation, financial or otherwise.

## PRIVACY STATEMENT

38. Entrants' and Nominated Entrants' personal information is collected from entrants by or on behalf of the Promoter to enable the Promoter and its agents to manage, administer and promote the Competition and, where applicable, publicise the winner(s). The personal information may also be provided to persons assisting the Promoter, including prize suppliers and deliverers, marketing agencies and IT providers, media outlets and related companies. By participating in the Competition, Eligible Entrants and Nominated Entrants consent to these uses and disclosures of their personal information.
39. If an Eligible Entrant does not provide the personal information the Promoter requests, the Promoter may not be able to enter them into the Competition.
